



GEETF Honorary Life Member Award Criteria/Nomination

Criteria and Conditions

Honorary Life Membership in the Grand Erie Elementary Teachers' Federation (GEETF) may be granted to an individual who has retired from the education profession prior to September of the school year in which the nomination is made and who has given outstanding service to the local and the Federation or as a member of the GEETF Staff.

The recipient(s) shall be given a GEETF pin and a gift, extended rights and privileges of being an Honorary Life Member. The recipient(s) will be honoured at the Annual Celebration Dinner in June.

CRITERIA

The Honorary Life Membership Award(s) may be granted to an individual who:

- a) Has retired from the education profession prior to September of the school year in which the nomination is made;
- b) Has not been retired for more than five (5) years; and
- c) Has given outstanding service to the Local and the Federation or as a member of the GEETF Staff in activities that may include but are not limited to the following: Local/Provincial Executive member, Local/Provincial Committee/Task Force member, Local/Provincial Workshop Presenter, member of the Local Representative Council, member of the Annual Meeting delegation, or any other activity which has contributed to the progress of the well being of the Local and/or the Federation.

PROCEDURES

1. Ensure that the attached documents are completed and submitted to the GEETF office no later than **Friday, May 12, 2023**.
2. Applications are processed by the GEETF Awards Committee and the committee's recommendations are taken forward to the GEETF Executive for consideration.
3. The Awards Committee is not a research committee. The Committee will depend on the information provided to establish the merits of any particular candidate as a possible award recipient.



SELECTION CRITERIA FOR HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

- Honorary Life Membership Award application forms should reflect the following selection criteria. Dates should be specified.
- In the selection of candidates for an Honorary Life Membership points will be awarded in accordance with the following criteria:
